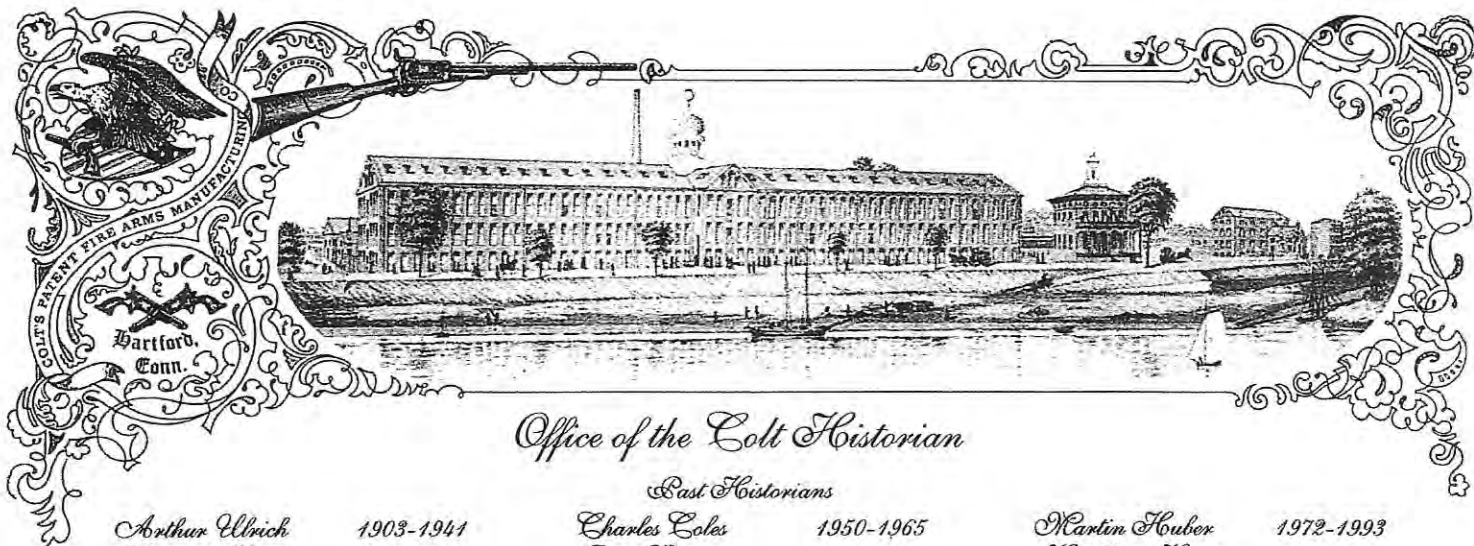

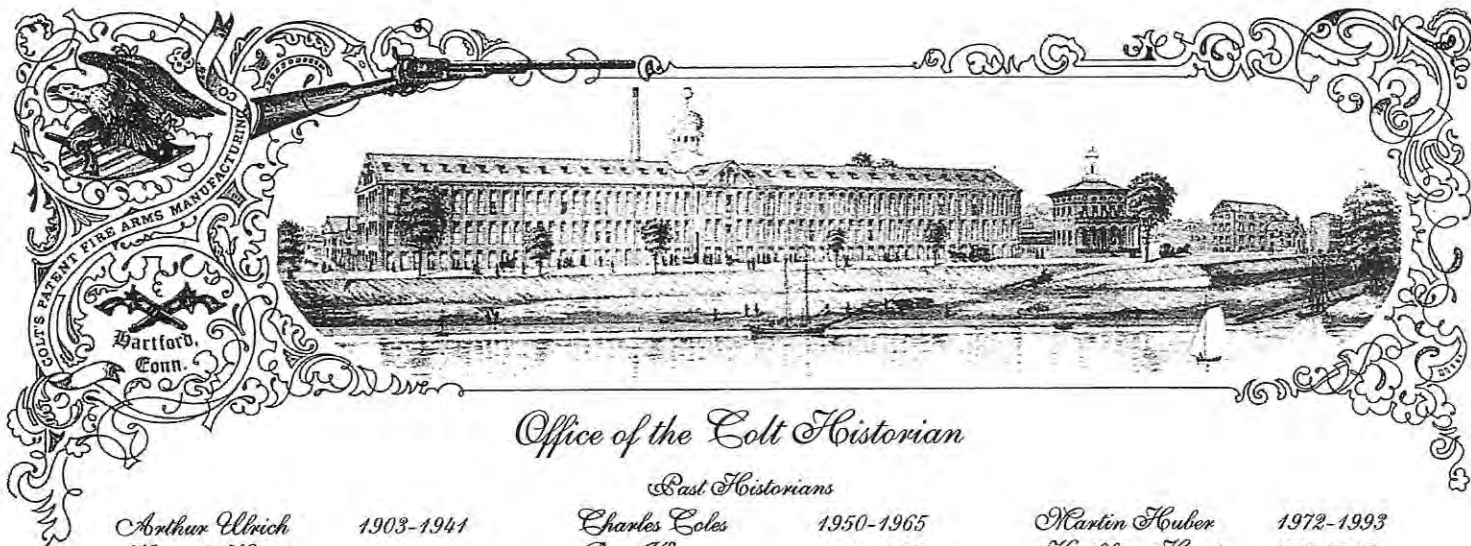

The records also indicate subject revolver was returned to the factory for refurbishing. The refurbishing consisted of replacement of worn parts, exterior refinishing, and reassembly. The barrels of these revolvers were not shortened.

The revolver was again delivered to the U.S. Government Inspector at the Colt plant on October 23, 1895.

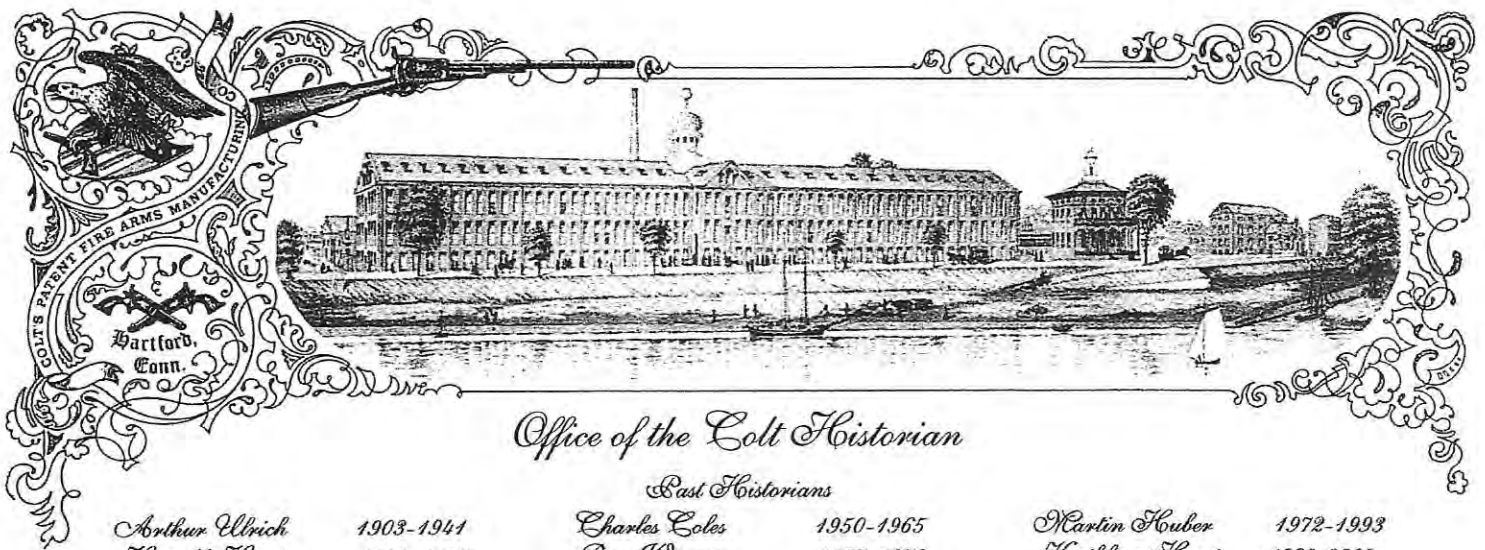
